- Committing every Tuesday and the 1st and 4th Saturday of every month to collaborative partner deliveries to clients.
- We received a newer used box truck through the Ion Bank Foundation.
- Analysis of our pickup service and associated donation amount was secured.
- Starting in May through the Give Local Campaign hosted by Connecticut Community Foundation, our organization has provided new mattress sets to every member of the family.
